Ralph A. Whitten Service Award

The Lions of Iowa Council of Governors created the Ralph A. Whitten Service Award in 1994-95. The first award was made in 1995 and an annual award has been made every year since. The award is presented at the International Banquet associated with the MD 9 State Convention each year. **The Whitten Service Award is only on the State level. District Service Awards may not use Whitten in their title.**

The Ralph A. Whitten Award is presented in honor of the memory of PID Ralph Whitten from Urbandale. PID Ralph served as an International Director during 1961-63 and was very instrumental in Iowa Lionism until his death in 1998. PID Ralph was a very service oriented Lion and the award was set up to honor other Lions for their exemplary service at the club, district and/or multiple district level.

The 2011 Award will be presented in Waterloo at the State Convention.

As is stated on the application blank, "This award is in recognition of DEMONSTRATED SERVICE at any level, club, district, and multiple district." **All nominations will be sent to the State Office in Ames.** Any club or individual may submit nominations. All nominations will be considered by the selection committee and finalists will be selected. From the list of finalists the committee will select the recipient. All nominations must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2011. Any nominations postmarked after that date will not be considered. Finalists will be notified and asked to attend the International Banquet at State Convention.

A committee of the Council Chairperson, two District Governors appointed by the Council Chairperson, and PID Gary Fry will select the winner. Every club and interested individual Lion is encouraged to select their most service oriented Lion(s) and submit a nomination to the State Office. There are many well deserving Lions who qualify for this award, so this year let us all select good people for this recognition in 2010-2011. **All nominations must be postmarked by no later than March 31, 2011.**
