G. E. "Bud" Klise Leadership Award

PID Norm Dean established the Klise Leadership Award in 1989. The award is to honor the memory of Past International Director G. E. "Bud" Klise of Stockport, Iowa in District 9X4. Lion "Bud" served as District Governor in 1976-77 and as an International Director from 1980-82. Past Director Klise exemplified leadership as he served his fellow man. All others in our International Association who came in contact with Lion "Bud" and his lovely wife Marilyn loved them. His life was cut short by a fatal traffic accident shortly after he had announced that he would be a candidate for the office of International Vice President. The award, which was first presented in 1989, is presented as a part of the International Banquet at State Convention each year. **The Klise Leadership Award is only on the State level. District awards may not use Klise in their title.**

The 2011 recipient will be named at the State Convention in Waterloo, June 4, 2011.

The purpose of the award is to honor the memory of PID Klise and to recognize an Iowa Lion who has demonstrated outstanding leadership ability at any level of Lionism, Club, District, Multiple District or International.

Any Lion or Club may nominate another Lion for consideration for the award. **All nominations will be sent to PID Norm Dean. Prior to October 31st at 3013 East 31<sup>st</sup> Street, Davenport, IA 52807. After November 1<sup>st</sup> and prior to the final date of March 31, 2011, applications should be sent to PID Norm Dean at 20016 North Greenview Drive, Sun City West, AZ 85375.** A nomination form is provided which must be used. All nomination forms must be typewritten. In order for a candidate to receive greatest consideration be sure to present supporting materials in detail.

A committee consisting of the Council Chairperson, Two District Governors appointed by the Council Chairperson, and PID Norm Dean, selects the annual Klise Award Winner.
